Dear Lakeview Families,

It has been a good first week back. I hope you enjoyed the Holidays. Things get busy very quickly. I want to start my message by finishing up the Dream, Believe, Act and Achieve series. Achieve is the last pillar of our vision defined. We want our students to feel successful when they reach short and long term goals. We want them to be proud of what they do. We want their success to translate to improved grades and new skills. We want this new knowledge to extend beyond the four walls of the classroom. This is the quote that sums up our feelings on Achievement: "If it does not challenge you, then it does not change you."

Speaking of challenges, I know that some parents are having trouble with the new math curriculum. I have been visiting math classrooms myself and have been amazed at the level of collaboration and team problem solving. I know it must be tough as a parent when your son or daughter comes home with math that is not neatly organized in the "step by step find the answer formula" of the past. That approach created students who could memorize the steps, but not necessarily understand the process. Our new math curriculum teaches both the steps and how to apply the math skills to multi step problems. Instead of having students come home with a sheet full of problems to solve, students are bringing home a few "real world" problems that students have to make thoughtful decision to solve. This takes one of the mathematical practices-persistence. Each math teacher at Lakeview has given students and parents access to resources on line to provide support in this time of transition. Please do not hesitate to contact me with questions or concerns.

I wanted to update parents on something that Lakeview is doing on a regular basis to highlight staff, classified and certificated, for their efforts. The school, with support of PTSA, purchased pins that go along with a short write up that specifies how that staff member makes a difference. - Check your students' grades weekly on Aeries /parent portal

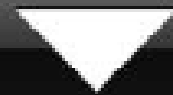


LOST AND FOUND
