Dear Lakeview Families,

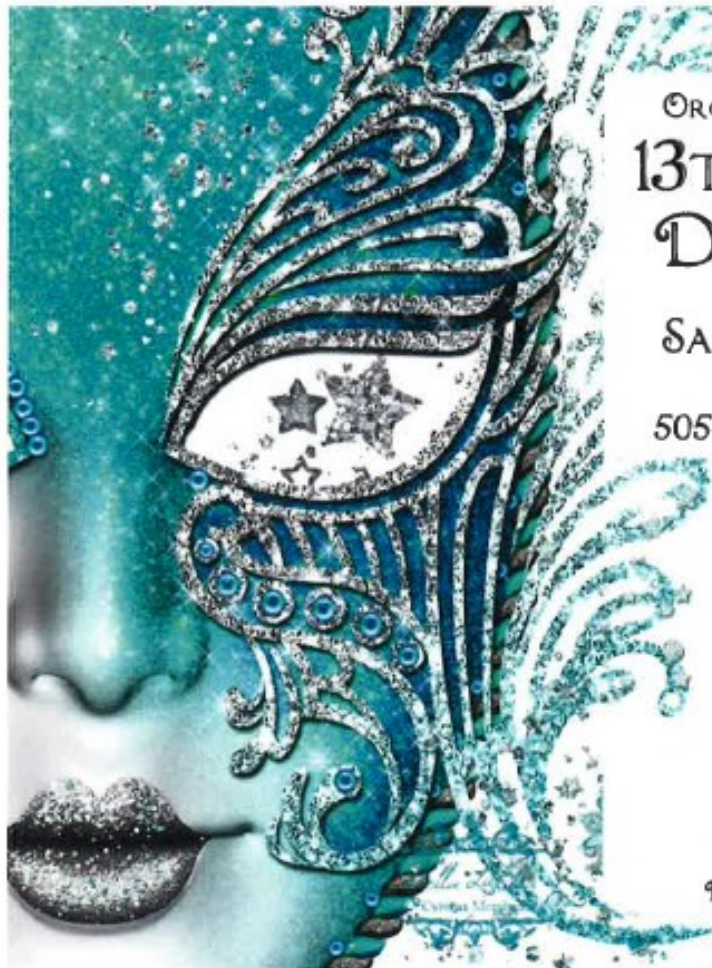

It is so important that students stay on top of their work as the 3rd quarter progresses. With that in mind, I want to make sure you know about our upcoming Progress Report conferences. On Wednesday, February 24th the students will receive their progress report to take home. The school will be holding evening conferences on Thursday, February 25th from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. The 25th will be a regular school day and there will be only the two hour block to meet with teachers. Teachers will be set up in the gym and the focus this time is on struggling students. All parents are welcome to drop in, but the school is targeting students who are not currently experiencing success in the classroom. Friday, February 26th will be a minimum day. There is always a lot going on at Lakeview. We are getting close to the mid-way point in our 8th grade Basketball season. Our boys and girls are both competing and representing the school very well. I am sure they appreciated the Rally we had on Tuesday to introduce and recognize their efforts. They are gearing up for the stretch run that will culminate in the Day Game with Orcutt Junior High on March 24th.
